The tool builds upon the data researched by hundreds of students and volunteers for <u>WikiRate's UK MSA Project</u>.

During February and March 2021, there is a volunteer opportunity for master level students to join the <u>WikiRate</u> and Walk Free teams in developing the ground truth dataset for Project AIMS.

- What you will do: You will specialize in a particular requirement of the UK Modern Slavery Act and investigate how a large sample of companies disclose (or not) this information.
- Your high-level contribution: Your assessments will help minimize the bias of the algorithm and build in the nuances.
- **The expected output**: A pristine dataset that will be the base logic of the algorithm that will find the relevant information within a company's Modern Slavery Statement.
